LETTER FROM THE PRESIDENT

ANDREW MCELWAIN SHARED HIS THOUGHTS PRIOR TO HIS DEPARTURE AS CONSERVANCY PRESIDENT IN JULY 2013.

Dear Friends,

While the Conservancy of Southwest Florida Nature Center remained closed for renovations much of the fiscal year, our work did not stop.

Initiatives during the 2012 fiscal year heavily focused on protecting one of our greatest natural resources – our water. Algae blooms, fish kills and closed beaches due to nitrogen and phosphorous pollution continued to demand our attention. At stake was the future of our water resources – the waters we rely on for a robust economy and quality of life. This multi-year struggle still continues and we are taking action on this issue on a daily basis,

Mines were being proposed near neighborhoods and environmentally sensitive lands. Western Everglades restoration, sea turtle research and Florida panther initiatives required our attention as well. Injured wildlife continued to arrive at our doorstep to receive treatment.

We remained a strong presence in the educational community, creating innovative ways to provide environmental learning. By developing unique field trips onsite at school locations, students explored nature in their own backyards to enhance science curriculum in local schools.

We enhanced community excitement about the soon-to-open Nature Center via ribbon cutting celebrations for the von Arx Wildlife Hospital.

Our volunteer corps remained busy as well, taking on new “behind-the-scenes” jobs to assist with daily wildlife hospital chores, helping at events, preparing the electric boats and assuming duties in administration.

The Conservancy also focused on our membership program. You told us in a research study that while you are a member because of the Conservancy mission, receiving more value for your membership was important. We rolled out a total new membership program, including incentives to upgrade and to renew. Members were also the first ones to see the progress and vision of the renovated Conservancy Nature Center and to hear Fabian Cousteau speak at the annual members meeting.

These are just a few of the important projects undertaken by the Conservancy in 2012. This annual report will provide you with more details of some of the year’s highlights.

We are able to accomplish so much because of your belief in us. Your participation in our annual fund-raising efforts, the Capital Campaign, donations and memberships make the difference. Together we can continue to inspire, inform and enable responsible environmental decision-making for people of all ages.

Some examples are the veterinarian endowment which allowed us to hire our new staff veterinarian so injured native wildlife receive immediate surgical and medical attention. ### CLEAN UP THE CALOOSAHATCHEE

Tired of slime, stench, algae outbreaks and threats to human health from the Caloosahatchee River, the Conservancy, along with other environmental partners, filed a suit against the Army Corps of Engineers for violating water protection laws and cutting off the Caloosahatchee’s water supply. The river suffered algae outbreaks eight of the past eleven years.

### CLEAN WATER! MORE FISH!

The 2011 RedSnook Catch and Release Tournament, co-chaired by Wayne Meland and Lloyd Liggett, generated a record \$115,000 to support Conservancy of Southwest Florida water quality protection programs and estuary and juvenile game fish research.

### FLORIDA’S “DIRTY WATER” RULES

Florida does not have quantifiable limits on the levels of excess nitrogen and phosphorus entering the region’s waterways. Conservancy of Southwest Florida continued a multi-year battle to set quantifiable limits to eliminate toxic outbreaks of algae and bacteria. A federal judge ruled favorably to uphold major elements of the Environmental Protection Agency water quality standards. However the struggle still continues.

### PARADISE FOUND

Thanks to Florida Department of Environmental Protection, South Florida Water Management District, Collier County and the City of Naples, a drainage ditch located at the Conservancy Nature Center was transformed into the Shotwell Wavering Filter Marsh. The filter marsh captures pollutants before they enter the Gordon River, acts as a respite for visiting wildlife, and serves as an outdoor “classroom” for environmental education programs.

### WATER QUALITY - IMPERIAL RIVER BASIN

Two southwest Florida watersheds in the Imperial River basin received enhanced pollution control due to technical reviews and comments provided by the Conservancy. Without this intervention, the State’s flawed assessment process would have prevailed and the watersheds would not have received pollution protection.

### EVERGLADES RESTORATION AND FRESHWATER

The Conservancy of Southwest Florida helped lead the 57-organizational members of the Everglades Coalition and sat on the board of the national Great Waters Coalition as the Everglades representative. These relationships help ensure that one in three Floridians, almost five million people, continue to get clean drinking water from the Everglades and restoration efforts.

### DECADE-LONG DISPUTE SETTLED

Conservancy of Southwest Florida and other environmental partners achieved protection for hundreds of acres of wetlands and restoration in a landmark settlement over the Mirasol project, a proposed golf course development in northern Collier County. The groups negotiated a significant reduction in the development footprint and preservation of additional wetlands within the Cocohatchee slough system – preserving wildlife habitat, water supply and flood protection.

### MINING WHERE IT BELONGS

Mining is an extremely intensive land use and its effects are felt far beyond its footprint – increased traffic, impact to drinking water supplies and wildlife habitat, all of which impact our quality of life. When a mining company proposed a mine in Lee County’s Density Reduction/Groundwater Resource area (DR/GR,) Conservancy of Southwest Florida successfully intervened on behalf of Lee county to locate mining to compatible and appropriate locations.

### CAPTIVA ISLAND BUFFERS SAVED

Conservancy of Southwest Florida partnered with the Sanibel-Captiva Conservation Foundation and the Captiva Civic Association to prevent a near-shore housing development on the north side of the island. Good science prevailed and the Army Corps of Engineers denied the permit to expand development since the developer had alternative, less environmentally-sensitive areas available.

### LEGISLATIVE MIXED BAG

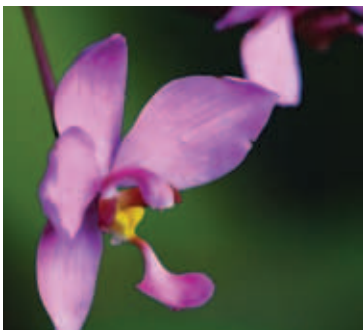
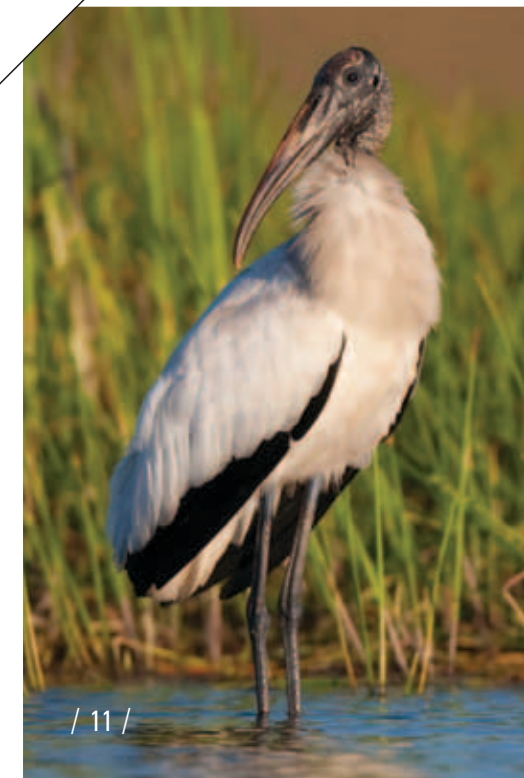
The Conservancy and other conservation partners worked with decision-makers and achieved State legislative approval for \$8.3 million in the 2012 budget to fund the Florida Forever state land acquisition program. While less than what was approved in previous years, the move was a step in the right direction.

### NATURAL SETTINGS

Generous donors to the “Saving Southwest Florida” campaign helped fund the purchase of precious upland scrub habitat adjacent to the Conservancy property. The protected land is now the Christopher B. Smith Preserve, which will be protected from development in perpetuity and is home to ~70 gopher tortoises monitored by the science team.

### HABITAT AND HISTORY

The Conservancy of Southwest Florida worked with residents of the Key Marco Community Association to develop a new conservation easement over 11 “Native Habitat Parks” within the development. The parks add to the quality of life for the residents and protect native wildlife and plants. The agreement also preserves the Indian Mound, which is among the oldest in North America.

### OVER 3,000 TREATED

Approximately 3,300 animals received care at the 1,800 square foot wildlife rehabilitation clinic. The wildlife team was able to release about half of them back into the wild. They were also very excited about moving in to the 5,000 square foot von Arx Wildlife Hospital. While the symbolic ribbon cutting occurred in April, 2012, the Hospital was not yet open until later in the year.

### PROTECTING PANTHERS

The Conservancy of Southwest Florida continued one more year of its pilot program to provide financial assistance to those who have experienced depredations by panthers. Ranchers may receive compensation funds for their free-ranging cattle that have been lost to panthers, as well as financial assistance to pet and livestock owners who would like to build a pen to protect them from depredation.

### TRACKING DEVICE

Conservancy of Southwest Florida expanded its sea turtle research to include the Kemp's ridley sea turtle and additional satellite tracking for the Kemp's and for loggerheads. Fifteen tags in all were deployed on both species by the Conservancy and other partners. Recording the daily movements and migration routes help define preferred turtle habitats, locate nesting sites, provide foraging and behavioral data, and direct administrators toward sound species management decisions.

### WILDLIFE BLOG

Director of the von Arx Wildlife Hospital, Joanna Fitzgerald, began writing weekly blogs about the Wildlife Hospital patients and shared them and photos with *Naples Daily News* readers and on [conservancy.org/wildlife-blog](http://conservancy.org/wildlife-blog).

### TROPICAL STORM DEBBY

Tropical Storm Debby wreaked havoc on sea turtle nesting and research equipment on Keewaydin Island. Prior to the storm, the number of nests were some of the highest ever seen. Unfortunately, only one-third the amount of hatchlings made it to the sea due to nest flooding. Since the effects of Mother Nature are cyclical, we are hopeful about the trends over time.

### KEMP'S RIDLEY BEHAVIOR

Kemp's ridleys did not undergo a seasonal migration from their foraging grounds in Charlotte Harbor estuary due to the unseasonably warm winter for 2011-2012. However, one of the turtles is believed to have perished after swimming through the harmful algae bloom from a persistent red tide event offshore/alongshore the southwest Florida coast. If water temperatures had been cooler, Kemp's ridleys would have responded by moving offshore and southward which would have exposed them to the red tide toxins.

### NEXT GENERATION OF ENVIRONMENTAL LEADERS

Conservancy environmental education team reached 6,840 students via Learning Adventures programs taken to the schools. The program was expanded to include an even greater number of schools in south Lee County, utilizing a leased vehicle provided by Subaru.

### MEMBERS: OUR FUTURE

Members told us they are engaged with the Conservancy primarily due to the mission, but also noted that additional benefits would be nice. So, the Conservancy launched a totally new membership program. Members now enjoy additional benefits and value from the base memberships and even more with Conservancy Club memberships.

### ENSURING OUR FUTURE

Generous donors provide the funds that support the daily work of the Conservancy to protect our paradise. The Leadership Circle (for giving above \$1,500) was expanded beyond the Board of Directors and Magic Under the Mangroves provided over \$750,000 in unrestricted funding. ### “CREATIVE” FIELD TRIPS

Delivering quality on-site Nature Center field trips for groups of students became quite a challenge while construction and sustainable renovations were underway. Thanks to the creativity of the education team, 2,530 children still learned about nature – both indoors and outdoors.

### INTERN PROGRAM

In 2012, 35 interns spent at least six months each working in various departments across the Conservancy – education, science, policy and wildlife rehab. The experience they received at the Conservancy has helped many former interns develop strong careers in the environmental field across the country and even internationally.

### EARTH DAY FESTIVAL 2012

Family spirits were high at the Conservancy of Southwest Florida Earth Day Festival on April 21 at the Conservancy Nature Center. Nearly 600 guests explored special environmental exhibits, interactive programs, puppet shows, entertainment, vendors’ wares, children’s carnival, face-painting, educational presentations and guest speakers. The event was sponsored by Fifth Third Bank, with additional support provided by Subaru and Florida Power and Light.

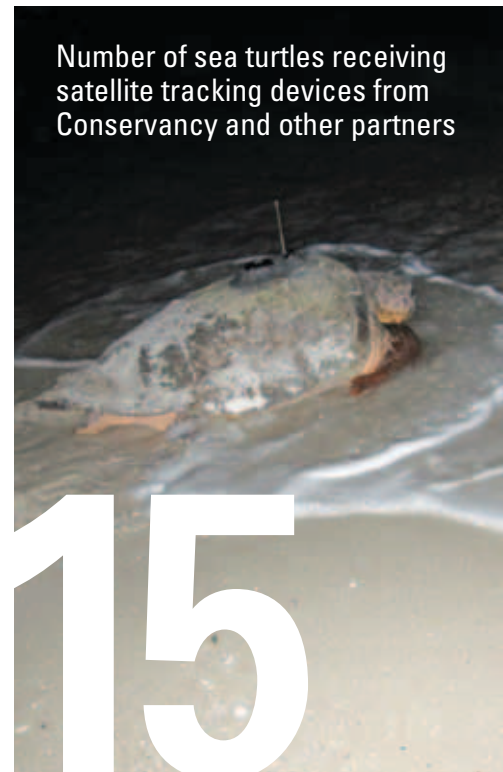

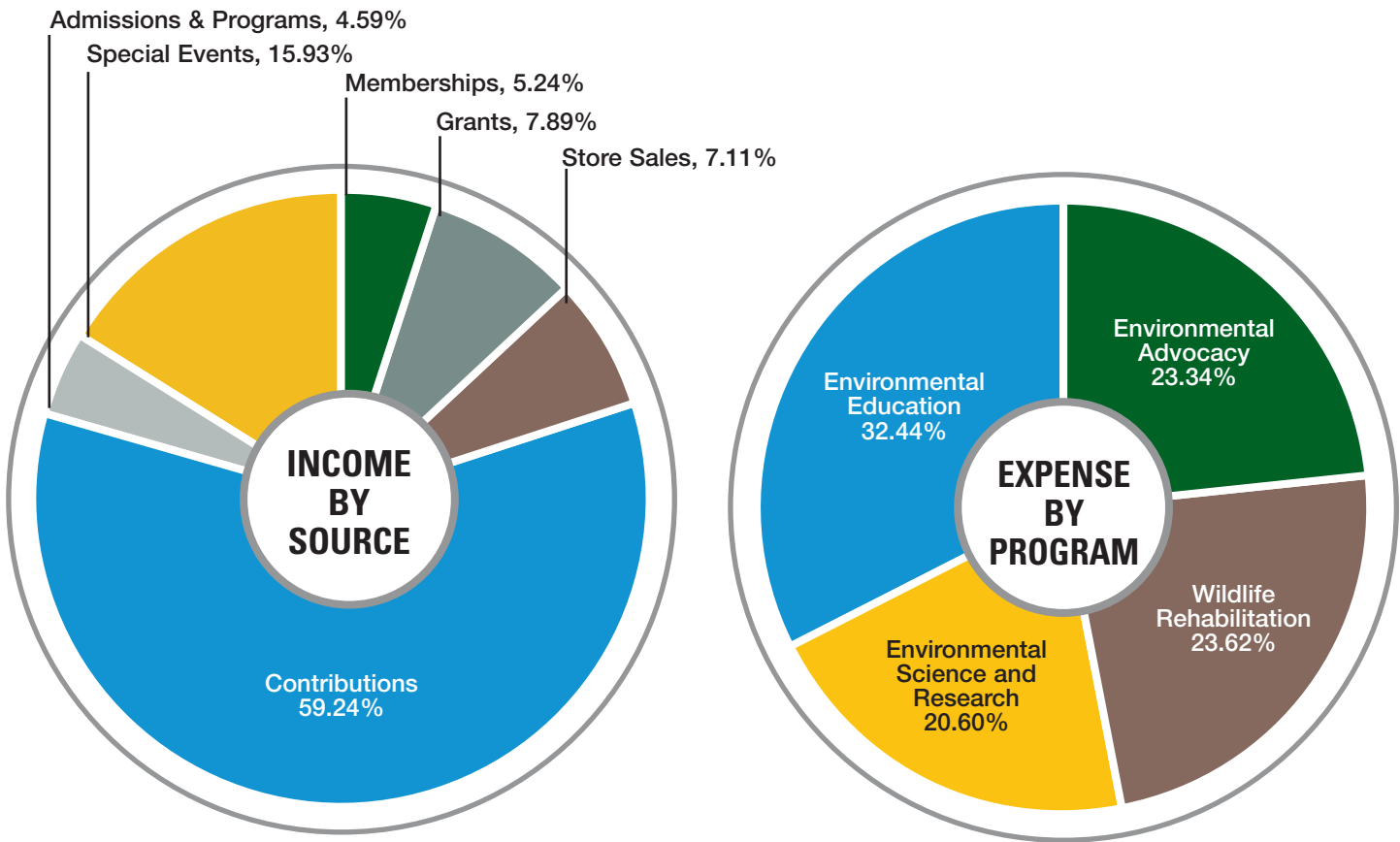
